



CURRICULUM GUIDE: GRAPHIC DESIGN CERTIFICATE

Requirements can be completed in one year at a rate of two courses per term and include the following:

Prerequisite (1)

- *Introduction to Graphic Design*

Studio Courses (4)

- Select four 30-hour courses from those listed under the subject heading **Graphic Design**; you may also use *Color Theory* as one of your required studio courses

Elective (1)

- Reflecting the degree program's interdisciplinary approach to an art and design education, all 30-hour Adult Continuing Education courses are eligible electives for all certificate programs.

Total required courses: 6

Completion of the Graphic Design Certificate requires a portfolio review, submission of a signed Certificate Program Completion Form, and a minimum of three (3) digital images from the student's body of work. The Certificate Program Completion Form can be found on the Adult Continuing Education *Forms and Downloads* page.

Note: Required courses may not be offered every term (fall, winter, spring, summer). Please contact Continuing Studies for suggestions on organizing your course sequence.
