



## CURRICULUM GUIDE: DRAWING CERTIFICATE

Requirements can be completed in one year at a rate of two courses per term and include the following:

### Studio Courses (4)

- Select four 30-hour courses from those listed under the subject headings **Drawing** or **Painting and Drawing**

### Art History Course (1)

- Select one 30-hour course under the subject heading **Art History**

### Elective (1)

- Reflecting the degree program's interdisciplinary approach to an art and design education, all 30-hour Adult Continuing Education courses are eligible electives for all certificate programs.

### **Total required courses: 6**

Completion of the Drawing Certificate requires a portfolio review, submission of a signed Certificate Program Completion Form, and a minimum of three (3) digital images from the student's body of work. The Certificate Program Completion Form can be found on the Adult Continuing Education *Forms and Downloads* page.

*Note: Required courses may not be offered every term (fall, winter, spring, summer). Please contact Continuing Studies for suggestions on organizing your course sequence.*
