SEVP/ICE Guidelines Rescinded!

As a result of the lawsuit by MIT and Harvard, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE)/Student Exchange Visitor Program(SEVP) has rescinded their proposed guidance for the fall 2020 semester regarding online learning. This means these policies will NOT go into effect for the fall semester.

- Information presented in the webinar on July 14 at 9 a.m. to continuing students may no longer apply to you in the same way
- International Affairs is actively seeking updates from SEVP to provide students clarity on existing and any upcoming guidance
- International Affairs is working with NAFSA, our national organization to understand how to properly and efficiently advise our students moving forward and will provide this information as soon as possible
- Any new requirements will be communicated to students as information becomes available
