GRAD BOOT CAMP

LOW-RESIDENCY MFA

Students in the Low-Residency MFA program begin their degrees with a six-week summer residency and are issued an I-20 to stay in the U.S. for the residency portion of the degree only. Low-Residency MFA students must provide \$20,032 in funding evidence.

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING COSTS

2021-22 on-campus housing in SAIC Residence Hall (double occupancy room rate at U.S. \$13,500, plus meals/food budget (\$3,600) is estimated in total at U.S. \$17,100.

DEPENDENTS

Students who will be accompanied by a spouse and/or a child/children must complete the dependent supplement located at saic.edu/international, under "Forms & Requests" and provide photocopies of each dependent's passport. Evidence of additional funding in the amount of U.S. \$6,300 (spouse only), \$5,300 (1 child only), \$11,600 (spouse + 1 child), or \$16,900 (spouse + 2 children) is required.
