INSTALLATION PARAMETERS

Entry in tight spaces or immersive installations.

Work that involves gatherings, audiences, or performative interactions that break recommendations for social distancing.

The Exhibitions Department staff will not be able to support installation that include intensive or complex factors such as:

- Site specific/immersive installations
- Three channel video projections
- Projection mapping
- Suspended work with a large number of individual components
- Elaborate media/equipment based installations
- Large number of small flat works in a grid or salon style
- Building of walls or major modifications to gallery walls or architecture

PROHIBITED MATERIALS

The following materials are prohibited :

- Painting of gallery walls.
- Sharpie markers, permanent inks, crayons, and oil pastels on walls, floors, or gallery furniture
- Adhesives/Glues on walls, floors, or gallery furniture (Adhesives include all but not limited to all glues such as: double-sided tape, sticky putty, resin, epoxy, Mod podge, wheat-paste, silicone, duct or gaffers tape, glue dots, etc.)
- Wallpaper (or wheat-pasting of any kind) on walls, floors, or gallery furniture
- Drawing or painting onto gallery walls or floors
- Oil-based or Impasto paints on walls, floors, or gallery furniture
- Graphite, charcoal, color pencil or chalk on walls, floors, or gallery furniture
- Fog machines
- Food, beverages, or liquids - excluding water in your work
- Bare, or spliced electrical wires, invented or altered electrical items
- Confidential materials, privacy & anonymity, permissions, copyrights, public interaction, and live recording audio or visual
- Tripping hazards, or projects that block pathways or egress
- Loose or uncontained glitter or micro-plastic
- Pharmaceuticals or medical supplies
- Loose particles that may be corrosive or harmful to breathe
- Spray paint or aerosols of any kind used inside the gallery
- Scented oils, perfume, or anything odorous

GALLERY AUTHORIZATION REQUIRED

Gallery authorization is required prior to install for the following:

- Dirt, plants, or debris (Must be store-bought and pest-free)
- Upholstery (Must be pest-free)- needs to be inspected by Staff
- Vessels or apparatuses containing water/ liquid
- Microorganisms
- Decaying organic matter/ rot
- Candles
- Soaps
- Providing additional lighting
- High volume levels and frequency
- Taxidermy
- Display of sharp or hazardous objects
- Weapon-like objects or replicas of weapons
- Exceeding assigned space boundaries
- Work that needs ongoing maintenance
- Installing vinyl

* If you need to drill a hole ½ inch or larger please speak to someone at the Help Desk first before drilling.
